

CONTESTANT INFORMATION - 94th PGA CHAMPIONSHIP

Congratulations on qualifying to play in the 2012 PGA Championship. To see the current field list please click on "Field List" under Contestant Information on the Contestant Website. The final field will be set on July 30, 2012.

Please note that all contestants in the 2012 PGA Championship (except international players) must be a PGA of America member in good standing on the opening day of the PGA Championship, and subject to the eligibility requirements set forth in the Entry Form. Airport Options - Click on "Airport Options" under Transportation Information on the Contestant Website.

Arrivals: If you fly into the Charleston International Airport, look for the PGA Transportation Desk located in Baggage Claim near the rental car desks under the "Airport Ambassadors" sign. PGA Transportation Volunteers will be wearing light blue golf shirts and black shorts. Contestants will have the option to be driven to Kiawah Island or be assigned a courtesy car and be responsible for driving themselves to the Ocean Course or where they will be staying.

Family members who do not arrive with the contestant at the Charleston International Airport will have access to the transportation committee subject to availability. Please advise the arrival time well in advance for scheduling purposes.

If you fly into the Charleston Executive Airport it is important that you let the Transportation Committee know in advance, as that desk will not be staffed unless an arrival is scheduled. Please call (843) 253-4802 to make transportation reservations.

Courtesy Cars And Transportation During The Championship - Mercedes-Benz, the official vehicle of The PGA of America, is pleased to provide the complimentary use of a Mercedes-Benz to all contestants in the field during the week of the PGA Championship. A courtesy car service will also be provided by volunteers during the week.

If you will be arriving between the hours of 9:00 am and 10:00 pm (August 4-7, 2012), transportation will be provided for you and your immediate family members from the Charleston International Airport or the Charleston Executive Airport. If you will be arriving after 10:00 p.m., you will need to make your own travel arrangements until the Transportation Committee reopens the following day. We recommend calling The Convention Store at 800-285-0001 to arrange for transportation. Advanced reservations are required. Payment in full is required at time of ride

Please note: Each person (contestant and spouse/partner) driving the car **MUST** sign and return the Mercedes-Benz Waiver Release form along with a copy of their driver's license. PGA of America regulations allow only players and their spouse/partner to drive the complimentary courtesy car. Click on "Mercedes Benz/PGA Courtesy Car Waiver Form" under Transportation Information on the Contestant Website to print and sign the form.

Kiawah Island Pass - Contestants: If you drive your own car to Kiawah Island please display the Kiawah Island Pass in order to gain access onto the island. Click on “Kiawah Island Pass - CONTESTANT” under Transportation Information on the Contestant Website and print the form. Please display on the front dashboard of your vehicle.

Contestant Housing Information: On-island Hotel Rooms at The Sanctuary, Villas and Private Homes have been blocked for contestants through Kiawah Island Resort.

If you would like to reserve housing click on “Contestant Housing” under Contestant Information on the Contestant Website.

Contestant Family and Guests Hotel Information: Because of the limited accommodations on Kiawah Island, the PGA of America has blocked rooms at the Holiday Inn Express & Suites Charleston Airport for Contestant Family Members who are not staying with Contestants and for Contestant Guests. This hotel will offer a complimentary shuttle to/from the Ocean Course each day. The room rate is \$149/night.

Championship Registration - (Sunday, August 5 – Tuesday, August 7). Hours of registration are 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. PGA Championship Registration will be in the Ocean Course Clubhouse. Please register before your first practice round. Anyone not registered by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 7, is subject to losing his place in the field.

Parking - Due to limited space, the Clubhouse Parking Lot is reserved for contestants only. If your spouse has a separate vehicle, parking will be available for her in a different lot at the course but farther from the clubhouse. A parking tag for her will be available at Contestant Registration.

Contestant Dining: The Contestant and Family Dining Room will be located in the Ocean Course Clubhouse. This area is reserved for Contestants and Family Members. Breakfast, lunch and an afternoon light deli will be served daily beginning Sunday, August 5.

Child Day Care – A complimentary Day Camp will be offered to children of Contestants from Wednesday, August 8 thru Sunday, August 12 at the East Beach Conference Center on Kiawah Island. Practice Rounds - The golf course and practice facilities will be available for play beginning at 7:30 a.m. on Sunday, August 5 and throughout Championship week. The 1st tee will close Wednesday at 3:00 p.m. for final course preparation. Practice round tee times (Sunday - Wednesday) do not need to be reserved as the 1st tee is open. If you would like to play before Sunday please call the Ocean Course Pro Shop at 843-266-4670.

Championship Rounds - Championship play will begin on Thursday, August 9 at 7:20 a.m. There will be 156 players in the field. The field will be cut to the low 70 players and ties after the end of the second round.

Credentials - As a contestant, you will receive an All Access contestant money clip. Your spouse or significant other, children, parents and parents in-law who attend the PGA Championship will gain access into the Championship as well as the Contestant Family Dining area in the Clubhouse. Because of security measures, a photo badge must be used by your family members in order for them to gain access into the Contestant Family Dining area.

**** If you are a PGA TOUR Member: This year we will use the photo badge issued to your family members by the PGA TOUR. Please ask your family members who accompany you (spouse, children, parents and parents in-law) to bring their badge. Children five years and older will need a photo badge.**

If you are not a PGA TOUR Member or if a family member does not have a photo PGA TOUR badge then see below:

- a) If family members accompanied you to last year's PGA Championship at the Atlanta Athletic Club then we have their photo on file and will make a badge for them. These badges will be available for you to pick up at Contestant Registration.
- b) If you did not play in last year's PGA Championship or family members did not accompany you then ask them to e-mail a head shot photo (.jpg format) to vraycrist@pgahq.com so that a photo badge can be prepared for them. These badges will be available for you to pick up at Contestant Registration.
- c) If you cannot send a .jpg file then ask your family members to accompany you to Contestant Registration at the Ocean Course. We will take their photo there and prepare a badge for them at that time.

Additionally, 4 complimentary tickets for each day (Monday through Sunday) will be placed in your registration envelope.

Please complete and return the Contestant Family Information form so that we can prepare for your family needs. Click on “Contestant Family Information” under Contestant Information to view and print the form.

Check Cashing - Contestants and Caddies may cash checks up to \$3,000. Checks in excess of \$3,000 require PGA Official approval. Checks must be drawn on an account that includes the players' name. No third party checks are acceptable nor are caddies' personal checks acceptable. Proper identification is required such as a PGA money clip or driver's license for players and caddie

card or driver's license for caddies. Checks should be payable to cash or to the individual cashing the check. To cash a check go to the PGA of America trailer located behind #1 tee.

Admissions (Player Guest Will Call) - Admissions (Will Call) will be operational beginning Monday, August 6, at 7:00 a.m. Ticket request forms will be available at Player Registration, the Locker Room and the PGA of America Office (located behind #1 tee) for your use and will be forwarded to Admissions (Will Call) on a regular basis.

Merchandise Discount - The PGA of America is pleased to extend a 20% discount on all PGA Championship merchandise to caddies, contestants and contestant spouses. To receive the discount, take your merchandise to the Customer Service aisle in the PGA Championship Golf Shop, located near the main entrance, and show your PGA Championship credential. Payment may be paid by cash, credit card or Travelers Checks.

Mobile Device Usage -The 2012 PGA Championship will allow spectators to carry and use mobile devices in select areas on the golf course. During the PGA Championship, spectators at the Ocean Course will be alerted to follow proper usage on site by adjusting the volume setting to "silent" or "vibrate." Spectators may accept or make phone calls in designated areas throughout the golf course, primarily near concession stands. Digital messaging and checking data is allowed on the golf course. Cell phone camera use is only permitted during the Practice Rounds. No video recording will be permitted at any time during Championship Week. Spectators attempting to use their mobile device in unauthorized areas or in ways not sanctioned will be asked to surrender the device and pick it up at a designated location after they depart the golf course.

All players must employ a caddie for the entire week for both practice and tournament rounds. If a Kiawah Island Resort caddie is used, the caddie fee is \$100 per day plus tip.
